Tour Itinerary

- Oct. 23** Our group departs from Indianapolis at 1:50pm bound for “promised land”. The international portion of our flight will be aboard El Al Airlines. When you board the plane you will feel that you are already in Israel.
- Oct. 24** We will arrive at Ben Gurion Airport named for Israel’s first Prime Minister at 3:50pm local time. We will then transfer to our hotel in Tel Aviv on the Mediterranean Coast.
- Oct. 25** Our journey begins today in the city where Peter first preached the Gospel to the house of Cornelius in Caesarea. From there we will ascend to the peak of Mount Carmel where Elijah had his fiery showdown with the false prophets of Ba’al. We will then descend into the Jezreel Valley better known as the Valley of Armageddon. We will take time to visit the ancient Tel Megiddo before leaving for a brief stop in Nazareth. Our first day will end on the shores of the Sea of Galilee. Overnight in Tiberias.
- Oct. 26** Today we travel north to the ancient site of Tel Dan. We will stand on the very location where Jeroboam erected the golden calf thus signaling the coming downfall of the northern kingdom of Israel. Afterwards we will visit Banias to see the headwaters of the Jordan River in the region known in the days of Jesus as Caesarea Philippi where Peter first uttered those amazing words of revelation, “thou art the Christ, the Son of the Living God”. We will also visit the mountain top view of the Damascus Road on Mt. Bental and then return to the Sea of Galilee for a sunset cruise on the Kinneret. Overnight in Tiberias
- Oct. 27** Our morning begins on the Mount of Beatitudes where Jesus preached the Sermon on the Mount. We will then visit the central city of Jesus ministry, the ancient fishing village of Capernaum. Here we will sit in the very synagogue where Jesus amazed the masses with His teaching and miracles He performed. After a visit to the Galilee Experience in Tiberias we will conclude our final day in the Galilee at the Jordan River. Overnight in Tiberias.
- Oct. 28** First stop today is the ancient city of Beit Shean in the Jordan Valley. We then continue driving south through the Jordan Valley till we reach En Gedi along side the Dead Sea in the Judean Wilderness. Our final stop will be the mountain fortress of Masada where we will learn the story of the final days of the Jewish Zealots who held out against the Romans until finally taking their own lives. Afterwards you may enjoy a float in the mineral rich waters of the Dead Sea or the Salt Sea as it is referred to in modern Hebrew. Overnight at the Dead Sea
- Oct. 29** Time for an adventure as we begin our day on camel ride into the Judean Wilderness. After our time in the Judean wilderness concludes we will begin to make our way “up to Jerusalem first stopping at Kiryat Gath to remember the battle between young King David the Goliath. As time permits we will visit locals for sunset views of the city before proceeding to our hotel in Jerusalem. Overnight in Jerusalem.
- Oct. 30** Before entering the Holy City we will pay a visit to Schindler’s Grave on the ridge of Mount Zion and then to King David’s Tomb and the traditional site of the Upper Room. Then we enter the Old City via the Zion Gate and begin our exploration of the Jewish Quarter. Inside the Jewish Quarter we will visit the Wohl Museum to see the underground remains of first century aristocracy of Jerusalem. Then we will visit the Temple Institute where today preparations have begun for the “third Temple”. After lunch we will sit on the Southern Steps of the Temple Mount and remember the Day of Pentecost in Acts 2. We will conclude our day with a time of prayer at the Western Wall. Overnight in Jerusalem.
- Oct. 31** We begin with a tour of the Rabbis Tunnel in the Old City and then visit the Pools of Bethesda before exiting the city via the Lions Gate. Our next stop is a difficult but necessary visit to the Yad Vashem Holocaust Memorial. There we will remember the 6 million Jews who lost their lives. Our final stop will be at the Israel Museum to see the Shrine of the Book where the Dead Sea Scrolls are on display and to visit the amazing scale model of Jerusalem. Overnight in Jerusalem.
- Nov. 1** Today is a Free Day in Jerusalem to explore and shop or just rest.
- Nov. 2** We call this last day, Yom Yeshua or Jesus Day. We begin on the Mount of Olives as we trace the steps of the final hours that led to the arrest and crucifixion and resurrection of Jesus. We will follow the palm Sunday path to the Garden of Gethsemane at the base of the mount in the Kidron Valley. From there we will go to the House of Caiaphas where Jesus was held during the night. Our day ends at the Garden Tomb where we will rejoice with those amazing words, He is not here for He is Risen! We then travel to Jaffa for our farewell dinner and transfer to the airport for our late night flight home to the USA.
- Nov. 3** Our flight will arrive in Indianapolis at 2:20pm.

PRICE INCLUDES:

- Transportation:** Roundtrip airfare from Indianapolis to Tel Aviv and return on El Al Airlines and its domestic air partners.
- Hotels:** Deluxe Hotel accommodations are based on double occupancy. A single room supplementary fee of **\$470.00** will be charged for those who desire a single room. Passengers traveling alone are responsible for paying this fee if no roommate is available. New Covenant Tours is not responsible for providing roommates.
- Meals:** Full Israeli-style breakfast buffet and dinner daily. **Lunch is not included in the tour price.** \$10 per lunch recommended.
- Baggage:** Information regarding baggage limits will be provided to all passengers before departure. Suitcases are limited to 50 pounds each.
- Taxes:** Current airfare taxes are included. **Additional surcharges or taxes levied shall be the responsibility of each passenger.**
- Tips:** Gratuities and tips have been included in the price. A love offering will be received for the guide and driver at the conclusion of the trip. NCT recommends a minimum of **\$30.00** per passenger.
- Touring:** All transfers are by deluxe air-conditioned motor coach. All entrance fees are included in the price. Sights added during the course of the tour may require additional fees from the participants on an optional basis. Tour itinerary and hotels are subject to change without notice.
- Late Fee:** Payments received within 29 days of departure are considered late and carry an additional fee of \$100.00
